

GENERAL

- All parents are welcome to view class from our lobby. We ask that parents do not enter the dance rooms during class as it creates a distraction for the dancers. Any questions or concerns should be brought to the instructor at an appropriate time. **Please do not take time out of a class to speak to an instructor.** You are always more than welcome to email, call, or speak to an instructor after class.

INITIAL HERE

- We take pride in providing a positive and nurturing environment for our dancers to learn. As a result, we ask that all conversations in the lobby be kept PG and negative comments/gossip be left outside studio doors.

INITIAL HERE

- Dancers are required to have the **proper dance shoes and attire** for any class they are enrolled in. We do have a small selection of shoes at the front desk, however these shoes are meant for new students only.

INITIAL HERE

- If a student comes to class without the proper shoes and attire, they will be asked to observe class and may not participate.

INITIAL HERE

- No soda, juice, or gum is allowed in the dance room... **Water Only.** Food and snacks are allowed in the lobby, but we ask that you and your dancers clean up after yourselves.

INITIAL HERE

- During class, all dancers must place their dance bags and gear in the appropriate cubbies in each dance room. Dance bags and gear should NOT be left in the lobby during class

INITIAL HERE



- Students are under steady observation by their teachers. Students must be able to execute proper technique to the fullest before they can move up levels. Once the teacher has determined that the student is ready to move up, the instructor will then move the student to a higher level. **Please be advised that class placement is at the discretion of the teacher.** Some students may take longer to progress than others, according to natural ability, effort, and practice.

INITIAL HERE

- Please email, call or text if your dancer will be absent from class. **Students that are too ill to participate in class should remain at home and rest.** If a student is injured, we strongly recommend that they come to class and observe even if they are unable to participate in the class.

INITIAL HERE

- Please be sure to arrive to class on time. **If a dancer is 10 minutes or more late, they may be asked to observe and take notes.**

INITIAL HERE

- Students are welcome to stay at the studio in-between classes, however parents may not drop off or pick up dancers more than :15 minutes before or after class. **If students are left at the studio after their classes, a babysitting fee of \$10 per 15 min will be applied.** If your dancer happens to be in the last class of the day, please be sure to pick them up on time to allow our staff to leave the studio as scheduled.

- We are not responsible for lost or stolen items, however we will do our best to return any lost items to their rightful owner.

TUITION

- Tuition is due on the **FIRST class meeting of each month**. Tuition can be paid at the front desk, online, or at a **discounted rate via Autopay**. Tuition received after the 7th of each month will be subject to a \$20 late fee.

INITIAL HERE

- **Tuition is based on enrollment, not attendance**. Monthly tuition will remain the same regardless of the number of weeks in the month. Some months will have five weeks of classes while other months will only have three weeks of classes due to holidays. **Tuition will not be adjusted for absences, holidays or performances.**

INITIAL HERE

- There are no refunds or makeup classes for missed classes, however makeup classes may be scheduled when the studio is closed on holidays. Makeup classes may only be taken if classes approved by the instructor and must be scheduled on our website at greenroomstudiosoc.com/info. **You will have one month from the missed class to participate in a makeup class.**

INITIAL HERE

- If you will be switching or discontinuing any classes, please let us know in a written notification or email at info@greenroomstudiosoc.com **at least two weeks prior to the change** so we can be aware of any new open slots for prospective students. You will not receive a refund for paid classes that you do not attend if you discontinue in the middle of a month.

DRESS CODE

BALLET:

- Leotard (color based on level)
- Tights (pink)
- Ballet shoes with elastic
- Hair secured in a bun
- As an option a dancer may wear dance shorts or a ballet skirt
- No baggy clothing allowed



ACRO:

- Leotard (any color)
- Dance shorts/pants/capris
- Hair in ponytail or bun



TAP/JAZZ/LYRICAL:

- Leotard (any color)
- Close fitting shirts or tank tops
- Dance shorts / pants / capris
- Hair in a bun or pony tail



HIP-HOP:

- Any dancewear is acceptable
- Hair should be pulled back



ALL CLASSES:

- ***Hair must be pulled off the face into a pony tail or bun and secured with gel, hairspray and hair pins.***
- ***We strongly recommend that dancers include a small hygiene kit (hair gel, hairspray, hair pins, a brush, deodorant and body spray) in their dance bag.***
- Short hair should be pulled away from face with pins or a headband.
- No jewelry should be worn in class as it is a hazard.
- Dancers are required to have the proper shoes for the class they are enrolled in.
- All dancers must be in the proper attire & hair or they may be asked to observe class.
- Please label your dancer's shoes with a name or initials.
